### PRIMITIVE HOMININS

Sahelanthropus tchadensis	7 - 6 mya	Chad
Orrorin tugenensis	6 mya	Kenya
Ardipithecus kadabba	5.8-5.2 mya	Middle Awash, Ethiopia
Ardipithecus ramidus	4.5-4.2 mya	Middle Awash and Gona, Ethiopia

### ARCHAIC HOMININS

Australopithecus anamensis	4.5-4 mya	Kenya
Australopithecus afarensis	4.3-3 mya	Tanzania, Ethiopia, Kenya and Chad, hands capable of making tools
Kenyanthropus platyops	3.5-3.3 mya	Kenya
Australopithecus bahrelghazali	3.5-3 mya	Chad
Australopithecus africanus	3-2.4 mya	South Africa, ate some meat
Australopithecus garhi	2.5 mya	Ethiopia; made some stone tools
Paranthropus aethiopicus	2.5-2.3 mya	Ethiopia and Kenya
Paranthropus boisei	2.3-1.3 mya	Tanzania (Olduvai), Ethiopia, Kenya, Malawi
Paranthropus robustus	2-1.5 mya	South Africa, ate some meat

### ARCHAIC HOMO (EMERGES AROUND 2 MYA)

Homo Habilis strict sense (transitional)	2.4-1.6 mya	Tanzania (Olduvai), Kenya, Ethiopia, South Africa; Oldowan tools, might not be Homo
Homo rudolfensis (transitional)	1.8-1.6 mya	Kenya and Malawi
Homo ergaster (Archaic Homo)	1.9-1.5 mya	Kenya and Georgia (Europe not U.S.); Acheulian tools, fire
Homo erectus (Archaic Homo)	1.8m -200 kya	Indonesia, China and Africa, S.E. Asia by boat 800 kya, Oldowan tools at least in Java
Homo antecessor (Archaic Homo)	700-500 kya	Spain, may be just archaic heidelbergensis, mostly Acheulian
Homo heidelbergensis (Archaic Homo)	600-100 kya	Europe, Middle East, Africa, China, India, mostly Acheulian
Homo neanderthalensis (Archaic Homo)	400-30 kya	Europe, Middle East and Western Asia; Mousterian tools
Homo Floresiensis (too new!)	18 & 40 kya	Hobbit people, modern tools

### MODERN HUMANS (HOMO SAPIENS)

Anatomically Modern Humans (Homo Sapiens)	200 kya to present	Found in sites in Africa (oldest sites), the Middle East, Asia and Europe and called different things in Africa and outside Africa, blades, projectiles, composites, microliths. Earliest remains from Ethiopia, found everywhere except Antarctica
Cro-Magnon (a name for modern humans in Europe and they are also Homo Sapiens)	35-10 kya	W. Europe, Aurignacian, Gravettian, Solutrean and Magdalenian tools
